

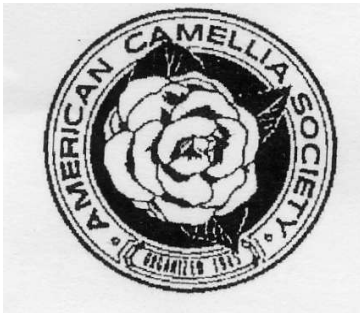

HORTICULTURE SHOW RULES

1. The Show will be conducted in accordance with The American Camellia Society Rules.
2. Entries (open to all growers) will be accepted from 7:30 until 11:00 on Saturday, Nov. 14.
3. There is no limit to the number of varieties that an exhibitor may enter, however, not over five of any variety.
4. Awards will be given at the at the discretion of the Judges and the Judges' decisions are final.
5. Stems two inches or less with one bloom and one or two leaves.
6. If only one bloom of a variety is entered, it shall constitute a class.
7. A bloom may receive only one award.
8. The authority for classification will be the latest edition of the Southern California Society nomenclature.
9. Exhibitors are requested to circle correct sizes for all single entries and to use correct color entry cards as are indicated in the horticulture schedules. Blooms with mismarked cards will not be judged.

- CLASS C – RETICULATA-OUTDOOR(GOLD CARD)
- CLASS D – RETICULATA-PROTECTED(GOLD CARD)
- CLASS E – NON-RETIC-OUTDOOR (BLUE CARD)
- CLASS F – NON-RETIC-PROTECTED(BLUE CARD)
- CLASS G – MINIATURE-OUTDOOR (WHITE CARD)
- CLASS H – MINIATURE-PROTECTED(GREEN CARD)
- CLASS J – COLL. OF THREE (SAME VARIETY) OUTDOOR (WHITE CARD)
- CLASS K - COLL. OF THREE (SAME VARIETY) PROTECTED (GREEN CARD)
- CLASS N – NOVICE (EXHIBITOR WHO HAS NEVER WON AN AWARD) (ANY COLOR CARD)
- CLASS O – SEEDLING (PINK CARD) OR MUTANT (RED CARD)
- CLASS P – SASANQUA OR OTHER SPECIES (WHITE CARD)
